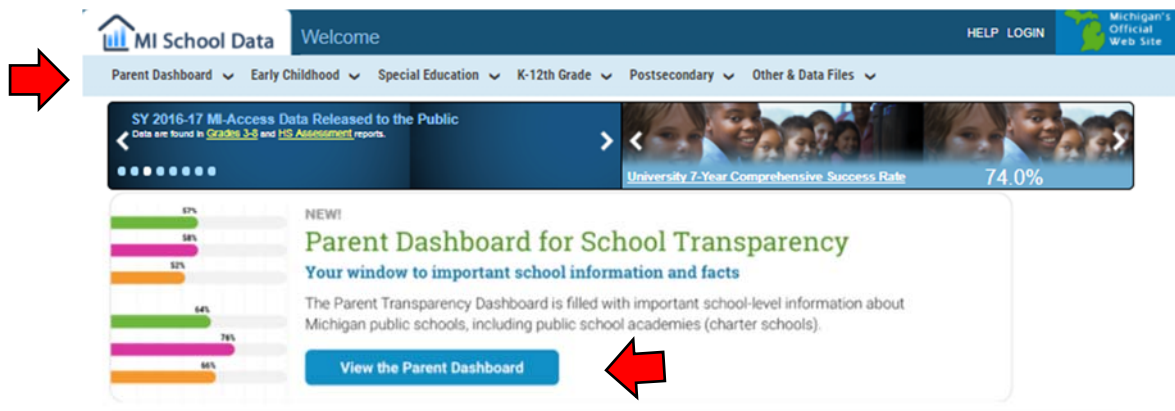
What is the Parent Dashboard for School Transparency?

How do you access the Dashboard?

There is no login required.

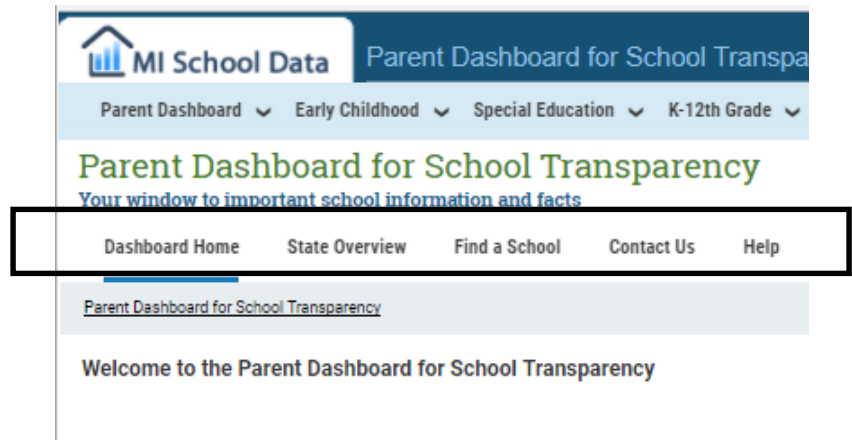
- Visit <http://www.mischooldata.org>

What is included in the Dashboard?

Within the “Parent Dashboard for School Transparency” you have several options:

Dashboard Home

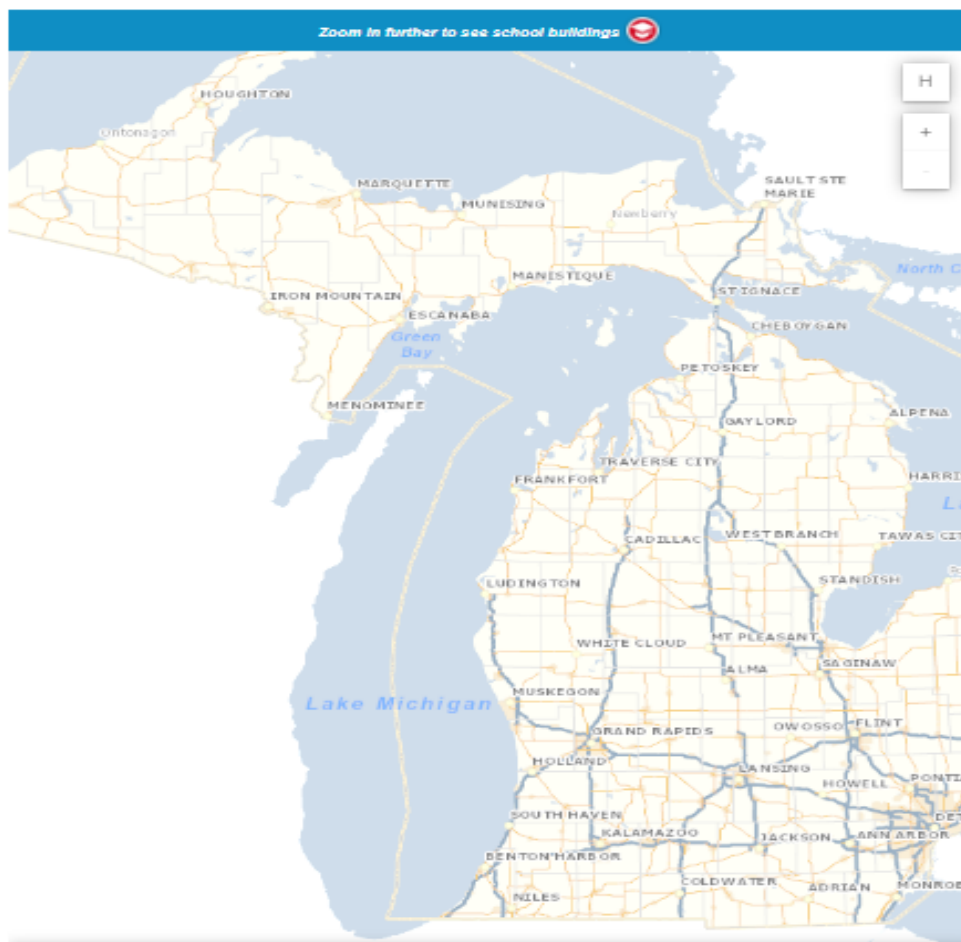
The Dashboard Home includes an option to “Search for a School”, or “Find a School by Map”. Key enter your school district to locate drill down.

REMINDER: The Parent Dashboard is for finding and reviewing information on a specific school (building) only. It is NOT a tool intended to provide information for a city, district, ISD, or region. 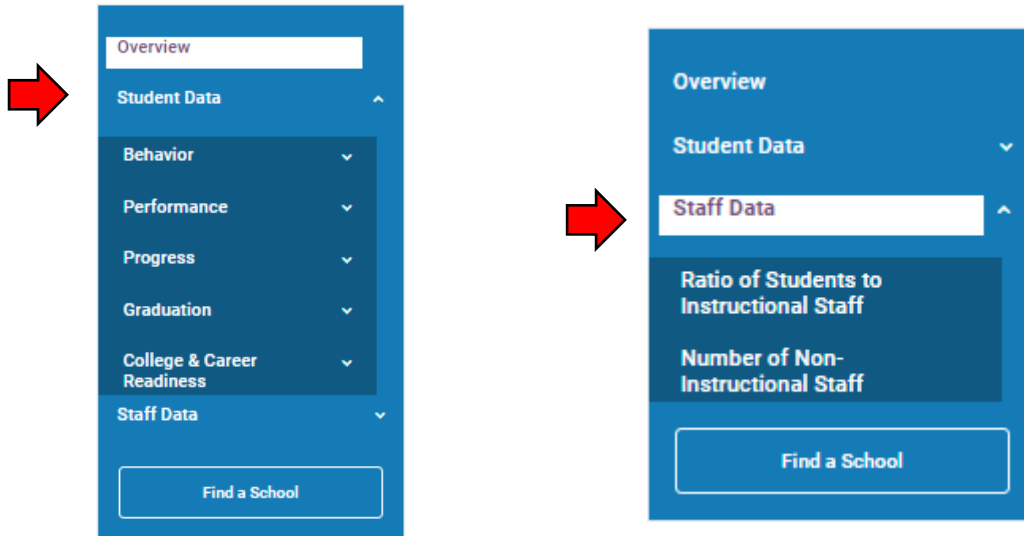

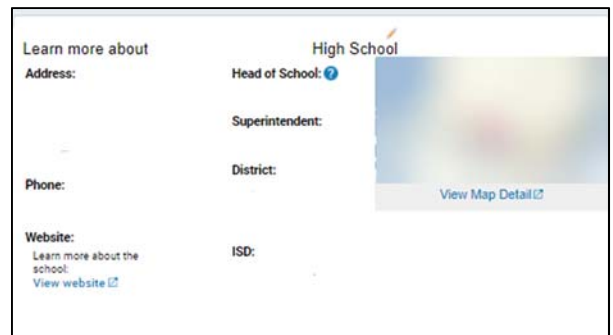
Use the search area to key enter your school, district, or county name.

The data sets include and Overview of **Student Data** and **Staff Data**:



The Dashboard includes **Contact Information**, including:

- Address
- Head of School
- Superintendent
- District
- Phone
- Website
- Intermediate School District



The Dashboard includes an **Overview of Key Performance Indicators**, including:

- **Performance Summary** (Percent of student proficient in all subjects on state tests)
- **Progress Summary** (Percent of students who are making progress towards proficiency or increasing their proficiency in all subjects on the state tests)
- **Graduation Rate** (Percent of students graduating from high school in four years)
- **Advanced Coursework** (Percent of students in grades 11 and 12 enrolling and passing in advanced coursework)
- **Postsecondary Enrollment** (Percent of student who enrolled in college after high school)
- **On-Track Attendance** (Percent of students who have on-track attendance)
- **English Learner Progress** (Percent of English Learner (EL) students who are showing progress on the WIDA test)
- **Assessment Participation** (The percent of students who were enrolled and took a state test. State tests included in this measure are the SAR, M-STEP, or MI-Access. Higher participation allows for a more complete picture of a school's performance on state tests).

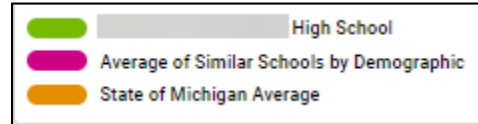

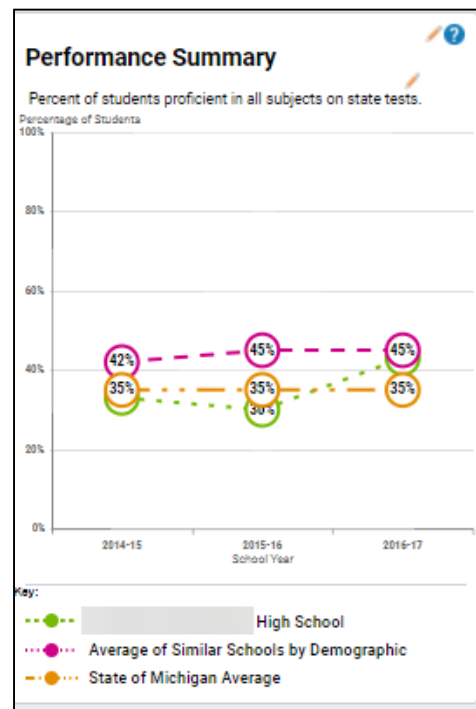
