Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2017-18 educational progress for the Mason Central Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2017-18 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

* Note TSI and ATS definitions were changed for the 2018-19 school year per federal requirements. The new definitions are:

TSI – The school has at least one subgroup performing in the bottom 25% within each applicable accountability index component.

ATS – The school has met the criteria for TSI identification and has at least one subgroup performing at the same level as a CSI school.

Mason Central Elementary School is striving to increase student achievement through the MTSS (Multi-Tier Student Support System) by providing specific interventions to meet each student's individual needs.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. Students as assigned to Mason Central Elementary School based on academic promotion as an eligible student at Mason Consolidated Schools.
2. Mason Central Elementary School is a school-wide Title I school. All components of 3-5 school improvement plan has been reviewed and revised by the leadership team with staff and parent input.
3. Students are selected for inclusion in specialized schools and programs based on the recommendation of an Individualized Educational Planning Committee. The purposed of the programs is to provide the best learning opportunities in a least restrictive environment in the general education program.
4. Mason Central Elementary follows all curricula that meet the requirements of the Common Core Standards along with the State suggested curriculum.
5. Mason Central Elementary School administers the NWEA Assessment three times a year Kindergarten through fifth grade.
6. Mason Central Elementary School had 96% parent attendance at the Fall 2018 parent teacher conferences.

Mason Central School continues to strive for excellence. Our staff, students, parents and community take pride in our accomplishments by working together to implement and follow our school improvement plan.
